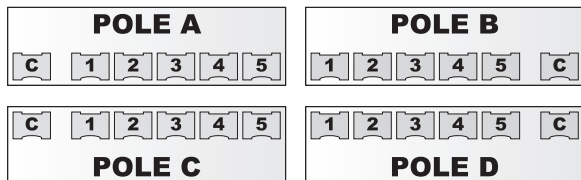


Our narrow superswitch is a 4-pole switch, meaning that it's really four switches in one. Each pole can be used to accomplish some specific function. The 24 switch contacts are laid out as shown in the illustration below. Each of the four poles has six contacts - one for each of the five switch positions (numbered **1-5** in the illustration), plus a common contact (labeled **C**).



This switch is far more versatile than a conventional 5-way switch, because it has a contact for each of the five positions. There are no shared contacts. But it is also quite a bit wider than a traditional 3-way or 5-way CRL switch, as used by Fender for many years in both Strats and Teles. Typically, a superswitch cannot be used in a Tele at all, as it will not physically fit in the control cavity. But we've had our switches custom made, and they fit perfectly in a standard Tele control rout.

They also work great in Strats where our ToneShaper pushbutton switch is used!
