



CA-CTRL-PLT-T

This is Callaham's standard control plate for Teles. It adheres to the dimensions Fender has used since 1950 with one exception: Callaham moves the volume control 3/8" in the direction of the tone control. The reason for this is so that when the switch is in the bridge pickup position, you still have space between the switch tip and the volume knob to get your finger in there. This can be a little difficult with standard Tele control spacing.

CA-CTRL-PLT-T-PPSM

The PPSM plate is made for us specifically to accommodate our pushbutton switch, which comes with certain of our Tele wiring kits. Callaham maintains Fender's original control spacing for all holes, but adds a hole for the pushbutton that's perfectly centered between the volume and tone controls (allowing the pushbutton, which is mounted to a pot, to be used as either a volume or tone control).

Callaham's plates are unplated stainless steel, which is similar in color to nickel-plated parts (stainless steel contains nickel).
